Student Application Process

Step 2:	Receive Conditional Letter of Admission <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After you receive your Conditional Letter of Admission, you will be required to forward tuition fees
Step 3:	Payment Confirmation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Receipt issued for Payment and Unconditional Letter of Acceptance issued • Once you receive your Unconditional Letter of Acceptance you can apply for your VISA
Step 5:	Visa Approval <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Once your visa is approved you must pay the remaining balance of your school fees • Book your flight and notify the school of your travel itinerary

REFUND POLICY

CIC is committed to fostering a learning environment that promotes the adoption of health enhancing attitudes and behaviors. It recognizes that personal well-being and positive school environment enhances academic success and may set a pattern for a life long healthy living standard. CIC prohibits alcohol and other illicit substances from all its residences and school properties. The use of any illegal drug(s) will lead to expulsion from school and residence.

Students admitted to Canadian Independent College are required to pay all fees in advance. When a student is unable to obtain a study permit/student visa, Canadian Independent College will refund the tuition fee less CDN \$550.00 processing and bank fees. To request a refund, the student must return all original Canadian Independent College documents and the original rejection letter from the appropriate government authorities or Immigration Canada.

When a student is asked by the Principal to withdraw from Canadian Independent College as a result of a disciplinary action, unused tuition fees will not be refunded.

When a student's application has been submitted to immigration and the family decides to withdraw the application, Canadian Independent College will refund the tuition fee less CDN \$2,500.00 processing and bank fees. To request a refund, the student must return all original Canadian Independent College documents and a letter stating the reasons for the application withdrawal.

When a student has been granted a study permit/student visa by the Canadian Immigration Authority but decides not to come to Canadian Independent College, no refund will be issued.
