History of Canadian Independent College

In 1858, with the help of five young women from the community of St. Agatha, Eugene Funcken, C.R. established a hostel care home for eight children left without care after fire ravaged their homes. The original hostel care home was an old log tavern rented from Peter Tschirhart . In 1868, a new hostel care home was built at a cost of \$5,000.00 on nine acres of land donated by Nicholas Dietrich

In 1870, Funcken travelled to Milwaukee to apply to Mother M. Caroline for the School Sisters of Notre Dame to take charge of the hostel care home. His request was granted, and in 1871 Mother M. Joachin and Sister Hunigundis arrived to take charge of the twenty children living in the hostel care and learning facility. In 1875, the separate school was added and supported solely by the people of St. Agatha Community. By 1902, the institution was enlarged to accommodate increased numbers of students that require the care and devotion of the institution. In 1966, Notre Dame of St. Agatha became a non-denominational hostel care institution for all students across the region.

Canadian Independent College (CIC Waterloo) continues the great history of passion and care towards its student population and community at large. The modern campus is located on 6.4 acres of picturesque valley in the Waterloo Region.

Waterloo Region is a mid-sized community located in the heart of southwestern Ontario's greenbelt. We have all the amenities of a large urban centre while still maintaining the charm and character of a smaller rural community. With a population of more than 540,000 people, Waterloo Region is one of the fastest growing areas in Ontario.
